The Minnesota State Colleges and Universities invites applications and nominations for the next President of Inver Hills Community College. Inver Hills is a comprehensive community college. The 90-acre campus is located in Inver Grove Heights, 10 miles south of St. Paul, in eight modern buildings that fit naturally into the surrounding wooded hills and wetlands. The college employs more than 370 faculty and staff and serves more than 8,000 credit-seeking and 2,000 Continuing Education/Customized Training students. Inver offers over 20 degree options, including liberal education courses (A.A.) that lead to transfer to four-year colleges and career-related degrees (A.S., A.A.S.) in leading occupational areas such as nursing, paralegal, law enforcement, computer networking technology, human services, business, emergency health care, and more. Scheduling is flexible and courses are offered in a variety of formats, including online, blended, and accelerated. A Center of Excellence for Access and Opportunity, the College encourages new students to participate in Learning Communities and a first-year experience course. Traditionally, about half of Inver Hills' students are working adults and part-time learners. Inver Hills participates in the Academic Quality Improvement Program (AQIP) alternate accreditation method. The College is part of the Minnesota State Colleges and Universities system. The system comprises 32 state universities and community and technical colleges. A team-oriented leader, the President will be responsible for directing all activities and functions of the college in conformity with board policies and federal and state regulations, and for expanding productive partnerships with all segments of education, the community, businesses, legislators, and other state agencies as well as other colleges and universities within the system. The successful candidate will have a minimum of a Master's Degree or equivalent, with a Doctorate from an accredited institution preferred. While successful senior level administration in a higher education environment is most directly applicable, comparable experience in business, government, etc., will be considered.
